





Sixteen Mile Creek Trail

Bronte Creek Trail

This 6.4-square-kilometre park is located on the western edge of Oakville. It includes five great hiking trails perfect for leisurely walks, breaking a sweat, picnicking, or enjoying the best of nature. This area is one of Oakville's most sought-after trail spots. Natural landscapes capture the beauty of the city and provide bountiful places to hang around the park and relax.





Munn's Creek / Shannon Creek Trail

In the heart of Oakville, this is one of the town's most beautiful trails. This park consists of greenery, waterfalls, and crisp, clear air. Munn's Creek consists of open concept grassland for recreation activities, or you can explore the Shannon Creek trail that further leads into the Sixteen Mile Creek Trail.

Waterfront Trail

Part of the Great Lakes Waterfront Trail – this trail features tree-lined streets, lovely homes, museums, two vibrant harbours, formal gardens and a system of river trails that run through wooded areas and meadows. The surface is a gravel path on the north side of Lakeshore Rd. from Burloak Dr. to Cudmore, and east of Belvedere to Fourth Line. The south side of Lakeshore Rd is for pedestrians.

Indulge in invigorating exploration, with cycling trails abundant in Oakville. Boasting over 193 kilometres of scenic, on-and-off-road cycling paths and a plethora of bike corrals and bike parking peppered throughout the town, you're all set for a thrilling adventure on two wheels.





PUBLIC TRANSIT

Distrikt Trailside's connected location brings you closer to all that you enjoy. Whether you're getting around within Oakville or commuting to elsewhere in the GTA, Trailside's prime position at the crossing of two major transit arteries makes getting anywhere a simple affair.

A DEDICATED THOROUGHFARE

Just outside your door is the Dundas Street West bus, which takes you straight across the top of Oakville and connects you to Oakville GO Station in the east and the 407 GO Carpool in the west.

Sheridan College and Oakville Trafalgar Memorial Hospital are just two of the noted stops along the way, and there are countless connection points to take you anywhere you want to go. With plans to add dedicated bus lanes on Dundas, getting around will be even easier.

EASY ACCESS
